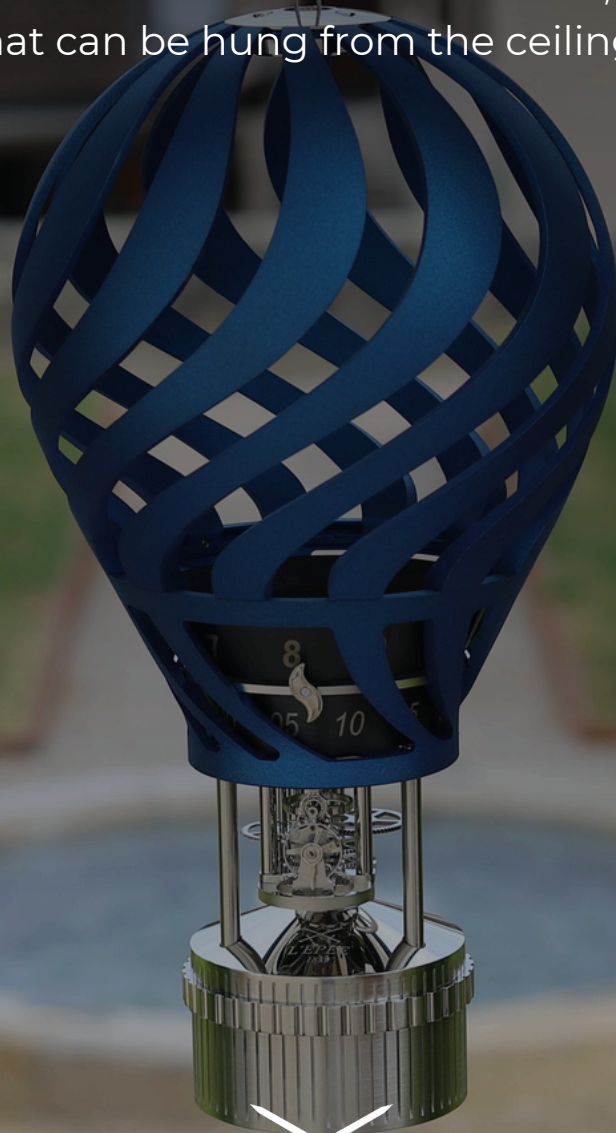

Inspired by the hot air balloon and all that it represents – travel, adventure, imagination, discovery, ambition, freedom L'Épée 1839 unveils a mechanical clock with impressive, sometimes floating presence which displays the hours and minutes for eight days.

An authentic piece of watchmaking art, Hot Balloon is an open-worked mechanical sculpture with a beautiful play of light.

Hot Balloon can also be admired from below, as is the very first mechanical clock that can be hung from the ceiling.



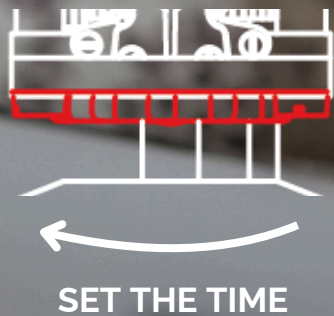

L'ÉPÉE

Open-worked sculpture carved from one single block of material

Two display options; On a surface or as a suspension clock attached with a strong cable provided

Hours and minutes displayed with central flame-shaped indicator in the balloon's burner

Time is set via the wheel above the basket
